IXP Neutrality

- A group of IXPs are working on a clear and well-accepted definition of IXP neutrality in the form of a standard, which lists specific, objectively measurable and verifiable IXP neutrality criteria that can be externally audited and certified.
- This should aide in marketing and defending pricing points

PeeringDB Feature Update

- IXPDB ↔ PeeringDB data sharing
 - IX-F Export Data Handling
- Better user handling for orgs
 - Can manage who your users are
 - Can require MFA for your users
- Can add IXP logo onto PeeringDB
- Reminder that PeeringDB is growing rapidly and needs more volunteers and sponsors

100G-LR4 vs 100G-LR

- Many IXPs have standardized 100G ports using LR4 optics
- BCIX wanted to ask if we should collectively update the standard to LR1 optics instead?
 - LR1 optics soon cheaper than LR4 optics

Route Server Hygiene

- AMS-IX suggested we should configure our route servers to impose limits on:
 - Number of BGP Communities
 - Type of BGP Communities
 - Maximum AS Path Length
