Update on BEREC Net Neutrality Guidelines

- ▶ Commission will not propose changes to the TSM Regulation.
 - ▶ The next evaluation should be carried out by 30 April 2023 the latest.
- ▶ BEREC plans to adopt the update its net neutrality guidelines
 - ▶ Stakeholders workshop 29.5.2019
 - ▶ Public consultation in October-November 2019
 - ▶ Target to publish the updated Guidelines is March 2020

What clarifications to traffic management rules can be expected?

- ▶ Some clarifications are being prepared, e.g.:
 - ▶ Differentiating Quality of Service (QoS) for IAS
 - ▶ Data compression
 - ▶ Blocking of content
 - ▶ What is a specialised service?
 - ▶ Impact of SpS on the general quality of IAS
 - ▶ Is hybrid IAS a fixed connection according to the transparency rules?
